FAQs

1. **What happens to all of the non-recyclable sports equipment at end-of-life that is collected in the Project Re-Bounce bins?**

Project Re-Bounce is part of MetroVancouver's waste-to-energy program. Materials collected are the renewable fuel that produces electricity purchased by BC Hydro.

2. **What's important about keeping end-of-life sports equipment out of landfill?**

Landfills are super emitters of methane, a greenhouse gas that is 84x more potent as a climate warming gas than CO₂.

3. **Did you know?**

It takes at least 400 years for a tennis ball to decompose in nature. Rubber is one of the longest duration materials found in landfills.
